<p><b>BD-5.8</b></p>	<p><b>Finance Committee Update</b> – Maria Martinez (Head, Organizational Services) &amp; Vanshika Dhawan (Treasurer)</p> <p><b>5.8.1 2025 Year-End Preliminary Results</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maria presented the 2025 Year-End Preliminary Results. Currently, staff are expecting to close 2025 with a \$191k surplus.</li> <li>• The surplus is due to more revenue than expected (increases in Government Funding, Enterprise &amp; Other) and fewer expenses than expected (savings in Salaries &amp; Benefits, Furniture &amp; Equipment, Services &amp; Rent).</li> <li>• Board members asked about a quarterly itemized delineation between recurring vs. one-time funding to better understand long-term forecast. This is already provided in risk analysis reports, however, the Finance Committee will revisit this suggestion and make a recommendation to staff that ensures the Board has a view into new and emerging funding trends, including what level of detail is appropriate for reporting purposes.</li> <li>• Consistent with Board direction provided in December 2025, the surplus will be directed to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary fund.</li> <li>• The audit is almost complete, and the auditors are expected to attend the Finance Committee meeting on May 25 and the Board meeting on June 8 to present the results.</li> <li>• The Board discussed the organization’s cash flow situation and flagged that there are significant delays (2+ years) in receiving the money owed as a result of core funding adjustments from the City of Toronto. This is a consistent issue across AOCCs, which staff have flagged, and are working with the City to hopefully implement some changes in the 2027 budget process later this year. Staff monitor the cash flow closely and have forecasts, plans, and back-up plans (i.e., line of credit) in case of emergency.</li> <li>• Staff also flagged key realities that may require future discussion regarding budget adjustments or re-allocation of funds: (1) continued cuts to IRCC funding and the implications for our work in supporting LGBTQ+ refugees, (2) ongoing rise in complexity of community and neighbourhood safety and The 519’s role in helping to address it, and (3) less government funding overall, less corporate funding overall, fewer available resources to fund new and existing work.</li> </ul> <p><b>MOTION 5.6.2:</b> To receive the 2025 Year-End Preliminary Results.</p> <p><b>Moved by:</b> Vanshika Dhawan</p>
