After losing Will Munro to cancer, a small group of family members and friends set up a fund in honour of the artist, activist, and party promoter.

The Will Munro Fund for Queer and Trans People Living with Cancer is dedicated to providing emergency financial assistance to LGBTTIAQQ2S people of all ages who are currently living with cancer in Ontario.

The annual fund of \$5,000 is allocated bimonthly based on need, as determined by the Will Munro Memorial Fund Committee, and is intended to help reduce financial hardship, improve quality of life, and enable people to focus on their health and their families.

We respond compassionately and prioritize members of LGBTTIAQQ2S who face multiple forms of marginalization, including but not limited to, people with low-income; Indigenous people; people with varying abilities; newcomers and refugees.
